An updated instance of Java is vital, especially when operating within Bb. It is also important to have a backup browser, such as Firefox.

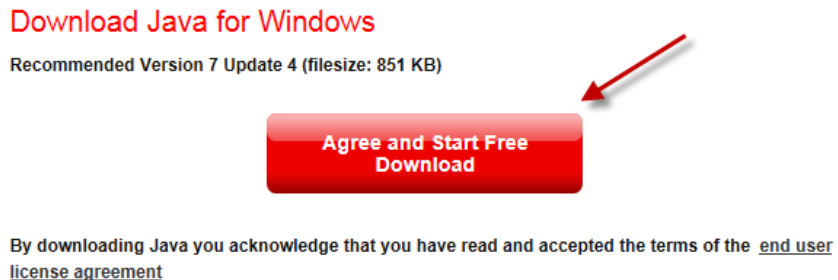
1. Navigate to:

WWW.JAVA.COM

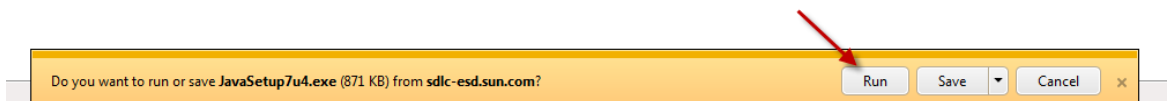
2. Click the **Free Java Download** button.



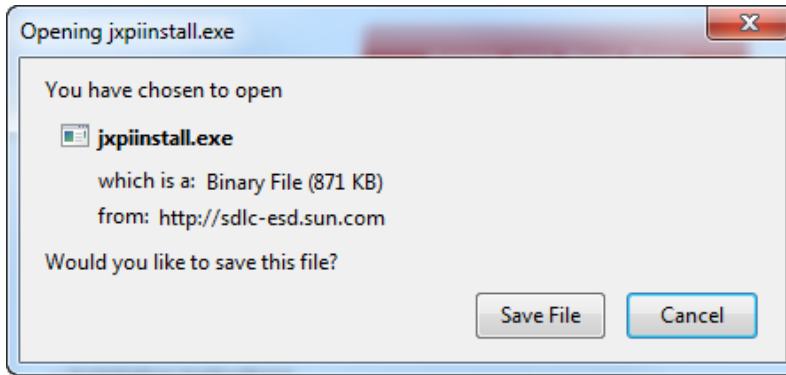
3. Click the **Agree and Start Free Download** button.



4. If you are running a more recent version of Internet Explorer, you will most likely see a popup at the bottom of your browser. Select **Run**



5. If you are using Firefox, you will see this popup (right). Here you can select **Save File**.



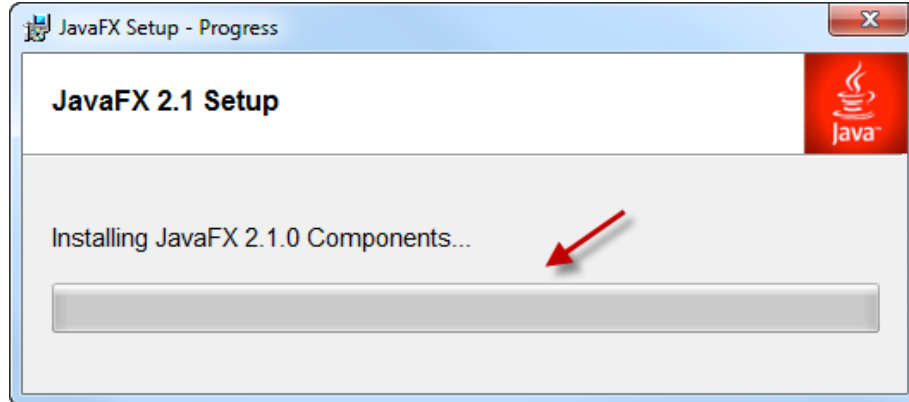
6. When you see this popup, select **Install>**.



7. You will see an installation popup.



8. And then another.






9. Once you receive a notice of successful installation, select **Close**.
